FINAL ORDER

ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

**Findings of Fact**

1. Ken L. and Beverly Hays filed an application to transfer the point of appropriation under Certificate 76525. The Department assigned the application number T-9333.
2. Certificate 76525 was cancelled by T-9184; the remaining rights are described by superseding Certificate 79681.
3. The application originally sought to transfer the point of appropriation for 0.3 ac in the NENE, Sec 11, T15S, R 14E, however no water right exists for that acreage. Therefore, on April 12, 2004 applicant agreed to withdraw that particular acreage from the proposed transfer.
4. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

**Certificate:** 79681 in the name of Wampler & Werth Farms  
**Use:** Irrigation  
**Priority Date:** December 11, 1978 (0.009 cfs) & December 28, 1978 (0.05 cfs)  
**Rate/Duty:** 1/80 cfs per acre, not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre  
**Acres:** 4.7  
**Source:** Five wells in the Crooked River Basin

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in an uncontested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

5. Application T-9333 proposes to move the authorized point of appropriation approximately one-half mile from the existing point of appropriation to:

6. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
7. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
8. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right is present.
9. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
10. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

**Conclusions of Law**


The change in point of appropriation proposed in application T-9333 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

The change proposed in T-9333 is hereby approved, subject to the following conditions.

1. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 79681 and any related decree.
2. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
3. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2005.
4. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2006.
5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available for this portion of the right at the original point of appropriation.
6. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
7. Certificate 79681 is cancelled; Certificate 80689 shall be issued to confirm the remaining rights.
8. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming the transferred water rights shall be issued.
