Findings of Fact

- 1. On January 16, 2015, the Department issued Special Order Volume 93, Page 1025 cancelling Permit S-52661 pursuant to OAR 690-320-0020.
- 2. On January 28, 2015, the Department received a request for reconsideration from the permit holder.
- 3. The request for reconsideration is granted.
- 4. The permit holder submitted information establishing that the appropriation had been made under the terms and conditions of the permit, therefore, the permit should not have been cancelled pursuant to OAR 690-320-0020.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-320-0020, beneficial use of the water within the terms and conditions of the permit was made.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Permit S-52661 is reinstated.
