**Findings of Fact**

1. On March 17, 2008, the Department issued an order approving the changes in place of use associated with Transfer Application T-10155. This order is recorded in Special Order Volume 74, Pages 369 - 372.
2. Following issuance of the order, Central Oregon Irrigation District notified the Department that the transfer map submitted had a hachuring error the affected both the authorized lands (from) and proposed lands (to) as described in the tables below:

*Note – Land affected is within same quarter-quarter and tax lot but is a different portion thereof.*


3. Upon notification the Department evaluated whether this corrected change would alter any previous determinations in use, ability of the district to deliver water to the corrected proposed place of use, enlargement and injury.
4. The Department finds that the corrected proposal is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.574 and 540.580.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The order recorded in Special Order Volume 74, Pages 369-372 is corrected to identify the proposed place of use for Certificates 83571 and 76714 as described in Finding of Fact #2.
2. All other provisions of the order are unchanged.
