Authority

OAR 690-380-6010(6) provides that a point of diversion or appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion or appropriation if the changes authorized under a transfer are not completed.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On June 20, 2007, D. Justin Meduri of Meduri Farms filed an application to add an additional point of appropriation under Certificates 28351, 30688, 33450, and 65496. The Department assigned the application number T-10411.
- 2. On May 18, 2010, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the proposed additional point of appropriation and a diminution of 4.3 acres under Certificate 65496 from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 80, Page 989.
- 3. On July 19, 2011, Jason Meduri of Meduri Farms notified the Department that the additional point of appropriation authorized under T-10411 would not be completed and requested that the authorized points of appropriation revert back to the original points of appropriation, being Wells #3, #4, #5 and #6.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The points of appropriation authorized under Application T-10411 are reverted to the points of appropriation authorized under the water rights prior to the transfer.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 2. The diminution of 4.3 acres of the right previously evidenced by Certificate 65496 from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation is confirmed.
- 3. Superseding certificates for the rights affected by the transfer shall be issued.
