



The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
15 S	10 E	WM	21	SW SW	998 FEET NORTH AND 1211 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 21

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This order is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 19, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 1338, approving Transfer Application 8743, and as modified by Special Order Volume 67, Page 226, supercedes a portion of Certificate 74135, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the right when it determines that it is necessary for record keeping.
