On May 20, 2002, Dan Hafner for Silver Mountain Farms filed application S-85180 for a permit to use the waters of the State of Oregon for irrigation use with the Water Resources Department.

The Department issued a Final Order on April 3, 2003, for application S-85180, approving the application upon payment of outstanding permit recording fees as described on the Final Order. The Department notified the applicant by certified letter on May 18, 2004, that the Department will issue a final order rejecting if the information requested is not received by June 18, 2004. The certified letter stated if there were any questions regarding the application that the applicant contact the department.


The applicant did not submit payment of outstanding permit recording fees and did not contact the department.

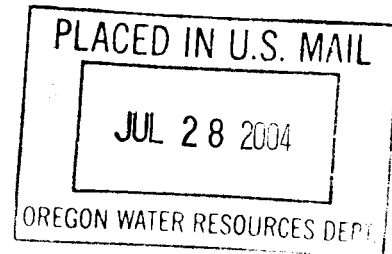
