T-14015, Yamhill County) A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department’s procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On May 19, 2022, FIONA ENTERPRISES LLC filed an application to change the place of use under Certificate 88973. The Department assigned the application number T-14015.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on June 7, 2022, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On August 10, 2022, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14015 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of September 12, 2022, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

4. On August 31, 2022, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-14015 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on September 6, 2022 pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
5. The Applicant requested a completion date of October 1, 2029, to allow for time to install an irrigation system and plant permanent crops.
6. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 88973 in the name of PEKKOLA FARMS INC. (perfected under Permit S-34938)

Use: NURSERY OPERATIONS on 105.0 ACRES

Priority Date: JUNE 25, 1970

Rate: 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for NURSERY OPERATIONS, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND and 5.0 ACRE FEET PER ACRE per year. The use of the water for NURSERY OPERATIONS may be made at any time, during the period of allowed use specified above, that the use is beneficial.

For irrigation of CONTAINERIZED NURSERY PLANTS, the amount of water diverted under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 5.0 ACRE FEET PER ACRE per year.

For irrigation of IN-GROUND NURSERY PLANTS, the amount of water diverted under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 ACRE FEET PER ACRE per year.

For IRRIGATION OF ANY OTHER CROP, the amount of water diverted under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre and 2.5 ACRE FEET PER ACRE during the irrigation season of each year.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

8. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
9. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14015.
10. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
11. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
12. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law


The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14015 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14015 is approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 88973 and any related decree.
3. Water right Certificate 88973 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer.
4. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
5. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2029**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
6. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.
