OAR 690-380-6010(6) provides that a point of diversion or appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion or appropriation if the changes authorized under a transfer are not completed.

Findings of Fact

- On May 3, 2010, Gordon C. and Judith D. Rose filed an application to change the point of diversion under Certificates 41771 and 81513. The Department assigned the application number T-11072.
- 2. On August 10, 2010, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the proposed change in point of diversion. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 81, Page 641.
- 3. On June 8, 2012, Gordon C. Rose and Judith D. Rose, and their agent Evan Malepsy of Public Works Management, notified the Department that the change authorized under T-11072 would not be completed and requested that the authorized point of diversion revert back to the original point of diversion.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The point of diversion authorized under Application T-11072 is reverted to the point of diversion authorized under the water rights prior to the transfer. Superseding certificates for the rights affected by the transfer shall be issued.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
