Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

Findings of Fact

- 1. On July 12, 2018, BLUE LINE FARMS, INC.; C/O ROBERT DETTWYLER AND KARL H. DETTWYLER filed an application to change from surface water points of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation under Certificates 20574, 64713, 67686, 75598, 75599, 87460, 87461, and 87462. The Department assigned the application number T-12969.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on July 17, 2018, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On September 16, 2019, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12969 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of October 15, 2019, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On November 19, 2019, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-12969 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on November 19, 2019, and in the Silverton Appeal newspaper on November 24 and December 4, 2019 pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 21. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 22. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-12969.
- 23. The proposed sump meets the requirements of ORS 540.531.
- 24. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 25. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 26. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change from surface water points of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-12969 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change from surface water points of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-12969 is approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 20574, 20574, 64713, 67686, 75598, 75599, 87460, 87461, and 87462, and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 20574, 20574, 64713, 67686, 75598, 75599, 87460, 87461, and 87462 are cancelled.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (POA Pond Sump), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (Abiqua West POD).
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (POA Pond Sump), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (Abiqua East POD).
- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. The use of water under these rights shall be subject to regulation consistent with other water rights from the surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original points of diversion.
- 8. The original date of priority shall be retained. However, if within five years after approving the transfer, the Department finds that the transfer results in substantial interference with existing groundwater rights that would not have occurred in the absence of the transfer, the proposed well shall be subordinate to any existing right injured by the transferred water right.
- 9. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2021**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.

10. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
