ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8021 submitted by

STAN ROLFNESS P.O. BOX 807 CHRISTMAS VALLEY, OREGON 97641

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 68562, was perfected under Permit G-10925 with a date of priority of APRIL 4, 1989. The right allows the use of A WELL, a tributary of the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 74.0 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.92 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ SW¼, Section 5, T 27 S, R 16 E W.M.; 1320 Feet North and 1320 Feet East from the SW Corner, Section 5, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

32.5 ACRES NE1/4 SW1/4 NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ 32.5 ACRES SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ 9.0 ACRES **SECTION 5** TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and continue to keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The use granted herein may be made only at time when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.

The quantity of water diverted at this point of appropriation, together with the quantity of water diverted at other points of appropriation for rights developed under this permit, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of appropriation.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the points of appropriation to:

for 0.81 cfs to the SW¼ NE¼, Section 30, T 26 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 60 Feet North and 1320 Feet West from the E¼ Corner, Section 30; and,

for 0.11 cfs to the NW¼ NW¼, Section 25, T 26 S, R 17 E, W.M.; 1320 Feet South and 1320 Feet East from the NW Corner, section 25.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

SW¼ SW¼ 9.0 ACRES SECTION 24 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

SW¼ NE¼ 32.5 ACRES SE¼ NE¼ 32.5 ACRES SECTION 30 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999.

- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. The water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The types and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificate 68562 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
