Findings of Fact

- 1. On August 24, 2005, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right from Oregon Department of Corrections, the landowner responsible for completion of the changes proposed in T-8457.
- 2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-8457 on July 17, 2000. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 54, at Page 534. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2001, and the date for submission of a claim of beneficial use as October 1, 2002.
- 4. The applicant has irrigated the 16.1 acres from the new points of appropriations as described in the order.
- 3. The applicant requested an extension of time because they have not fully completed the claim of beneficial use report as described in the order.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-8457.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the change in place of use and point of appropriation, authorized by T-8457 shall be extended to October 1, 2005.
