
**Findings of Fact**

1. The Department issued an order approving Instream Transfer Application T-11868 on July 18, 2016. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 101, Page 441. A new remaining right certificate was also issued as evidenced by Certificate 91697.
2. Remaining right Certificate 91697 contains a scrivener's error in the table that describes the place of use to which the water right is appurtenant. The table describes the number of acres of irrigation as 23.99 acres. However, the number of acres identified did not account for the cancellation of 1.97 acres also identified in the order approving Instream Transfer T-11868. The correct number of acres remaining following approval of the instream transfer is 22.02 acres.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. Water right Certificate 91697 is cancelled.
2. Water right Certificate 91836 is issued to supersede Certificate 91697 and to correctly describe the number of acres to which water may be applied.
