Authority

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On December 14, 2016, East Fork Irrigation District (EFID) filed a district transfer application to permanently change the places of use under Certificates 92000, 80829 and 84803. The Department assigned the application number T-12538.
- 2. Notice of the District Permanent Transfer Application was published on December 27, 2016, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 92000 in the name of EAST FORK IRRIGATION DISTRICT (confirmed by

the Hood River Decree)

Use: IRRIGATION of 1.5 acres

Priority Date: NOVEMBER 25, 1895

Rate / Duty: ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 ACRE-FEET for

each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Source: EAST FORK HOOD RIVER, tributary to HOOD RIVER

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Within 20 days after this final order is issued (i.e., mailing date), the district or any protestant may file with the commission exceptions to the final order. The commission shall issue an order granting or denying the exceptions within 30 days after receiving the exceptions. ORS 540.580(10).

- 5. The Department finds that the district permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000 contains the information required under OAR 690-385-4200 and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-4300.
- 6. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 7. The proposed change in place of use will not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 8. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The proposed changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-12538 satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed change in place of use to the water right evidenced by Certificates 92000 is approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 92000 any related decree.
- 3. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.
- 4. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 5. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2018**. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by EFID to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.

6. Water right certificate 92000 is modified. The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the right when it determines it is necessary for record keeping.
