ORDER

APPROVING APPLICATION

On May 25, 1945, Deschutes County, Clifton McGuire and Lawrence McGuire filed an application for a change in place of use of water stored in Crescent Lake Reservoir, within the boundaries of the Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District.

In the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of the Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District for the irrigation of, among other lands, 20 acres in the $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 6, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W. M., from the waters stored in Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of March 20, 1911.

The applicants herein, owners of the above-described land and water right appurtenant thereto, propose to transfer the water right therefrom without loss of priority to 20 acres in the SE2 NE2, Section 30, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W. M., owned by Clifton McGuire and Lawrence McGuire.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides that notice is not required in applications for only a change in place of use of water.

All the lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District, the board of directors

having submitted written approval of the proposed change in place of use of water.

It appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDFRED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved and that the water rights hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 20 acres in the SET NWT, Section 6, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W. M., be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 20 acres in the SET NET, Section 30, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that complete application of water to beneficial use on the land to which the water is transferred hereby shall be made on or before October 1, 1946, or such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
