ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. May Park Water Ditch Co. filed an application to transfer the point of diversion under Certificates 6477, 6537, 6552, 6570, 77031. The Department assigned the application number T-7910.
- 2. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

10. Application T-7447 proposes to move the authorized point of diversion to:

- 11. Notice of the application for transfer was published on January 27, 1998, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. The Grande Ronde Improvement District filed a protest of T-7910 on February 16, 1999 in response to the notice, but withdrew the protest on May 18, 1999.
- 12. There are mapping deficiencies and discrepancies in the application that need to be corrected in order to meet OAR 690-380 standards. A letter of deficiency was mailed April 23, 1998, explaining various discrepancies, and requesting the applicant to submit amendments to the application.
- 13. An amended application was received March 4, 1999 modifying the lands involved in the transfer. On June 26, 2000 a letter was received further amending the application. However, the application and map still do not meet the standards in OAR 690-380, and information received by the Department indicates that the May Park Water Ditch Company may not currently have a functioning board of directors responsible for acting on behalf of its members to remedy the deficiencies.
- 14. A letter was mailed February 23, 2006, to all property owners of lands identified in the application, explaining the current situation and notifying them that if they wanted to pursue the transfer they needed to notify the department by March 23, 2006 or the transfer would be rejected. No comments were received.
- 15. On March 28, 2006 a draft Preliminary Determination was mailed to the May Park Water Ditch Co. at the address of record, with copies to all affected landowners, proposing to reject the transfer application unless specified deficiencies were remedied by April 28, 2006. No response was received.
- 16. On May 22, 2006 Preliminary Determination was issued, proposing to reject T-7910 due to failure to meet OAR 690-380-4010(3) completeness requirements. Notice of the Preliminary Determination was published in the Department's weekly public notice on May 30, 2006. No protests were received.

Conclusions of Law

The proposed change in point of diversion in application T-7910 is not consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000 because it does not meet the standards for completeness in OAR 690-380-4010(3). Therefore the application is incomplete.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The change in point of diversion proposed in application T-7910 is rejected. The application is of no further force or effect.
