Findings of Fact

- 1. The Department received a voluntary cancellation request from Tammy Harty to cancel 8.4 acres of irrigation under Permit G-16874.
- 2. The Department has determined Tammy Harty is the recorded owner, as established by county deed records, of the water right evidenced by Permit G-16874.
- 3. Permit G-16874 allows for the appropriation of 0.105 cubic feet per second of water for irrigation of 8.4 acres. The date of priority is March 10, 1998.

Conclusions of Law

The Director of the Oregon Water Resources Department concludes the portion of the right evidenced by Permit G-16874 has been abandoned and shall be cancelled.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. Permit G-16874, dated October 20, 2011, is cancelled and is of no further force or effect.
- 2. The Department shall issue Permit G-18127 to describe the remaining portion of the water right NOT cancelled by the provisions of this order.
