FINAL ORDER APPROVING AN
EXTENSION OF TIME

Findings of Fact

1. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-8996 in the name of Dieter & Jacquelyn Konnegen, on June 29, 2005. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 65, at Page 245. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2006.
2. On September 3, 2010, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-8996 from Dieter & Jacquelyn Konnegen.
3. The applicant has completed all changes authorized in the final order with the exception of installing a metering device. The applicant has irrigated 38.3 acres.
4. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2011.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-8996.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-8996 shall be extended to October 1, 2011.
