Authority

OAR 690-380-6020 establishes an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time for the completion of changes authorized under water right transfers.

Findings of Fact

1. On April 17, 2015, the Department received an application for an extension of time for water right Transfer Application T-8031 from Sangeet Khalsa.
2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-8031 the names of Katherine Sherrill and Patricia A. Brown and recorded it in Special Order Volume 78, at Page 898 - 901. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2010.
3. On April 17, 2015, the Department recorded an assignment of the transfer application from Katherine Sherrill and Patricia A. Brown to Sangeet Khalsa.
4. Since approval of the transfer application, as evidenced by Special Order Volume 53, Pages 290 - 292, ownership of the affected property has changed. Sangeet Khalsa became the owner of the property in late July 2009.
5. In order to fully complete the transfer consistent with the terms and conditions of the order, the applicant will need to install a flow meter at the point of diversion.
6. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2016.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer and the requested time is reasonable.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-8031 shall be extended to October 1, 2016.
