ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6616 submitted by

COLEMAN FARMS 16783 FRENCH PRAIRIE ROAD WOODBURN, OREGON 97071.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 29043, was perfected under Permit G-354 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 10, 1956. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 144.8 ACRES. amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW% SW4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN ST. PAULS CATHOLIC MISSION DLC 75, SECTION 19, T 4 S, R 2 W, W.M.; WELL - N 85° 21' E 68.11 CHAINS FROM THE SW CORNER OF DLC 75, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ 15.0 ACRES

BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN ST. PAULS CATHOLIC MISSION DLC 81 SECTION 24

SW¼ NE¼ 11.0 ACRES

SE¼ NW¼ 9.7 ACRES

NE¼ SW¼ 32.7 ACRES

NW¼ SW¼ 26.0 ACRES

NE¼ SE¼ 1.0 ACRE

NW¼ SE¼ 23.8 ACRES

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN ST. PAULS CATHOLIC MISSION DLC 75 SECTION 19

TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

WELL 1 - NE% SW%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN ST. PAULS CATHOLIC MISSION DLC 75, SECTION 19, T 4 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1250 FEET SOUTH AND 1670 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST % CORNER OF SECTION 19.

WELL 2 - SW¼ SW¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN SAUVE DLC 62, SECTION 19, T 4 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 2500 FEET SOUTH AND 150 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 19.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the 4. original point of appropriation.

Certificate 29043 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
