**ORDER REJECTING TEMPORARY TRANSFER APPLICATION 9191**


Temporary Transfer Application 9191, in the name of G-2 Farming, LLC, was filed July 18, 2002. The applicant requested a temporary change in the place of use and point of appropriation for certain water rights.

Water Resources Department staff examined the transfer application and found that the proposed point of appropriation is developed into a different source of ground water than the authorized point of appropriation. ORS 540.523 allows for a change in place of use and point of appropriation, however it does not authorize a change to a different source of water. In addition, staff found that the temporary transfer proposes to divert and use ground water from two different critical ground water areas.

Enlargement and injury to existing rights would result from the requested changes in accordance with ORS 540.523. The transfer application can not be processed and should be rejected.

Temporary Transfer Application 9191, in the name of G-2 Farming, LLC, is REJECTED and of no further force or effect.
