ORDER CORRECTING PERMITS

Permits numbered R-4563 and 30364 were issued to Rogue River Valley Irrigation District June 10, 1965, with a priority date of January 20, 1955, which was the date the applications were received by the State Engineer.

As authorized by Chapter 87, Oregon Laws 1913, the State Engineer withdrew from appropriation unappropriated waters of Rogue River and its Tributaries above Raygold for projects under investigation or to be investigated. By an order entered September 6, 1960, the State Engineer restored to its status before the withdrawals all waters except for storage and use of direct flow of North and South Forks of Little Butte Creek, Dry Creek, tributary of Antelope Creek and Antelope Creek for Agate Dam and Reservoir project. The Agate Dam and Reservoir project is that described in permits numbered R-4563 and 30364 and the priority dates of these permits should have been September 6, 1915.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the priority date of January 20, 1955, listed for permits Nos. R-4563 and 30364 be stricken from the record and the corrected priority date of September 6, 1915, be shown.
