On April 7, 1975, Howard S. and Verna G. Stone of PO Box 1097, Walla Walla, Washington 99362 submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 10142, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of United States Reclamation Service, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.57 cubic foot per second of water from Umatilla River, with a date of priority of March 28, 1909, for irrigation of 8.0 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 20, Township 5 North, Range 27 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 10142, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
