ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 8535 submitted by

JACK CORREA
31317 ANDREW ROAD
ECHO, OREGON 97826.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 76051, was perfected under Permit 25924 with a date of priority of JUNE 27, 1958. The right allows the use of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 118.1 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.79 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 21, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M.; WESTLAND CANAL - NORTH 76 DEGREES 45 MINUTES 56 SECONDS EAST, 2913.19 FEET FROM THE W $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 21, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 75126, was perfected under Permit G-6339 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 1, 1975. The right allows the use of

WELLS 1 AND 3, in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 19.3 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.12 CFS FROM EACH WELL , if available at the original well; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 16, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 850 FEET NORTH AND 750 FEET WEST; WELL 3 - 350 FEET NORTH AND 850 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 16, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein for supplemental irrigation shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The diversion shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The third right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 61534, was perfected under Permit G-7078 with a date of priority of MARCH 30, 1976. The right allows the use of BROWN WELLS 1, 2, 3 & 4, in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 98.9 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original wells; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 20, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 30, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 80 FEET NORTH AND 2500 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 20; WELL 2 - 610 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 30; WELL 3 - 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 1310 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 30; WELL 4 - 140 FEET NORTH AND 490 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER, SECTION 19, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right allows the use of BROWN WELL 2, in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 19.2 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original well; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 30, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 610 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 30, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

The right allows the use of the waters of MCKAY RESERVOIR, constructed under reservoir Permit R-564, a tributary of MCKAY CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 74.8 ACRES. The authorized point of diversion is located as follows: MCKAY DAM - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 34, T 2 N, R 32 E, W.M..

The water use shall comply with the terms and conditions of a valid Water Service Contract between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.



THESE TEMPORARY CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The change is temporary. The change shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
2. The former place of use shall not be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2001 and 2002 irrigation seasons.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2002 irrigation season.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
5. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificates 76051, 75126, 61534, 75128, and Permit 7400 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 76051, 75126, 61534, 75128, and Permit 7400.
