**ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND  
POINT OF APPROPRIATION**

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8013 submitted by

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The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 31072, was perfected under Permit G-2017 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 15, 1961. The right allows the use of WELL 4, a tributary of the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 39.0 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.42 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW¼ NW¼, Section 22, T 27 S, R 17 E, W.M.; 10.5 chains East and 10 chains South from the NW Corner, Section 22, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 52876, was perfected under Permit G-8984 with a date of priority of MARCH 31, 1980. The right allows the use of A WELL , a tributary of the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 7.47 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.10 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW¼ SE¼, Section 3, T 27 S, R 17 E, W.M.; 1320 Feet North and 1340 Feet West from the SE Corner, Section 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SECTION 3

TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

The third right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 75533, was perfected under Permit G-9125 with a date of priority of JANUARY 13, 1981. The right allows the use of WELL 2 , a tributary of the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 8.67 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.11 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, T 26 S, R 16 E, W.M.; 2640 Feet North and 1320 Feet West from the SW Corner, Section 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

LOT 10 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )	1.98 ACRES
LOT 9 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )	1.68 ACRES

SECTION 4

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 12, T 27 S, R 16 E, W.M.; 1325 Feet South and 1349 Feet East from the W $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 12.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

5. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.

Certificates 31072, 52876 and 75533 are canceled. New certificates will be issued to confirm those portions of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
