On February 15, 2002, the Water Resources Department (Department) issued a Final Order described as Certificate of Water Right Number 79201 in the name of Grande Ronde Valley Irrigation Company. Within 60 calendar days after the date of the order, the Department may, on its own initiative reconsider the Final Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Water Right Certificate No. 79201, in the name of Grande Ronde Valley Irrigation Company, describes a right to appropriate 17.44 cubic feet per second of water from Grande Ronde River, tributary of Columbia River for irrigation of 1395.5 acres of land in Union County, Oregon.
2. Water Right Certificate No. 79201, was dated, issued and mailed to Grande Ronde Valley Irrigation Company on February 15, 2002. Water Right Certificate Number 79201 is a Final Order in Other than a Contested Case.
3. The Department may, on its own initiative, reconsider the Final Order.

ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Water Right Certificate Number 79201 is a Final Order in Other than a Contested Case and may be reconsidered by the Department on its own initiative within 60 days of the date of the Order.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
