Findings of Fact

1. On August 03, 2007, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right from Central Oregon Irrigation District for Transfer application T-9981.
2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-9981 on September 13, 2005. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 67, at Page 114. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2006.
3. The applicant has beneficially used all water authorized in the tax lots except for 1.25 acres in tax lot 181309 NE NW 600.
5. The applicant needs to have a new delivery system installed to irrigate the acres of land in tax lot 181309 NE NW 600.
6. The applicant has requested that the time for completion be extended to October 1, 2008.

Conclusions of Law


Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-9981.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the changes in place of use authorized by T-9981, shall be extended to October 1, 2008.
