This order confirms the right of record to use the waters of THE CROOKED RIVER, A TRIBUTARY THE DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 103.5 ACRES.

This right of record was confirmed by certificates 72283 and 72284, perfected under permit 33954, in the matter of ERIC D. INGALSBE, TRUSTEE of the CAROL B. INGALSBE TESTAMENTARY TRUST, c/o NORTH UNIT IRRIGATION DISTRICT. The date of priority is September 18, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.59 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is further limited to the combined total of water for all other rights perfected under Permit 33954 which shall not exceed 200.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND. The amount of water will be measured at the points of diversion from the sources.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is further subject to the terms and conditions of a stipulation between the North Unit Irrigation District and Oregon State Game Commission which has been recorded in the miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Director.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water right certificates 72283 and 72284 are modified. The Department shall issue water right certificates on a determination that it is necessary to produce certificates describing the water rights.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in certificates 72283 and 72284.
