Findings of Fact		
1.	On July 28, 2014, the Department received a voluntary partial cancellation request for 4.1 acres, owned by Attila Koppany, to be irrigated under Permit G-16859.	
2.	Pursuant to OAR 690-017-0100(2)(a), the Department has determined Mike Kelley, Attila Koppany and Tami Foster are the recorded owners, as established by county deed records, of the water right evidenced by Permit G-16859.	
3.	Permit G-16859 allows for the use of 0.16 cubic feet per second of water for irrigation of 12.6 acres. The date of priority is January 12, 2011.	
Co	Conclusions of Law	
The Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the portion of the right evidenced by Permit G-16859 has been abandoned in accordance with the provisions of ORS 540.621 and shall be cancelled.		
Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:		
1.	Permit G-16859, dated July 21, 2011, is cancelled and is of no further force or effect.	
2.	The Department shall issue Permit G-17333 to describe the remaining portion of the water right NOT cancelled by the provisions of this order.
