Authority

ORS 540.570 and 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On December 13, 2012, RRVID filed a District Transfer Application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 85288, 85876, 85877, 80575, 80576, 80577 and 83729. The Department assigned the application number T-11501.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 18, 2012, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On December 26, 2012, the Department received a facsimile from Jackson County Development Services requesting the Transfer Application applicant contact the Planning Department as one of the users served may require additional land use permitting.
- 4. On January 15, 2013, the Department received a telephone call from Jackson County Planning explaining that they had erroneously reported that additional land use permitting may be required of one of RRVID's user and "withdrew" their request for additional contact.
- 5. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

- 20. The District permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 21. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 22. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.

23. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-11501 satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The proposed change to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 85288, 85876, 85877, 80575. 80576, 80577 and 83729 are approved.
- The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 85288, 85714, 80575, 80576, 80577, 83729, 85876 and 85877, and any related decree.
- The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
- 4. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2015. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 5. Certificates 85288, 85714, 80575, 80576, 80577, 83729, 85876, and 85877 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the rights when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.
