O R D E R


On October 18, 1976, Carl H. and Eunice M. Groth submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right evidenced by certificate issued to Milton Freewater & Hudson Bay Irrigation Company and recorded at Page 13083, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates as established by Decree of Circuit Court for Umatilla County entered May 16, 1932, and is for the appropriation of not to exceed one and one-half miners inches per acre measured at point of diversion on the Little Walla Walla River, with a date of priority of February 16, 1903, for the irrigation of 14.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right evidenced by certificate recorded at Page 13083, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
