**Authority**

OAR 690-385-7600 describes the process for the Water Resources Department to issue a water right certificate upon determination that an applicant has made satisfactory proof of completion of the changes authorized by a final order approving a district permanent transfer.

**Findings of Fact**

- On August 13, 2010, the Department issued an order determining satisfactory proof on Transfer Application T-9981. This order reduced the water rights evidenced by Certificate 83571 and 76714 by 0.40 acre. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 81, Pages 793 – 795.
- The order contains scrivener’s error in the quantity by which Certificate 83571, at point of diversion #11, would be reduced. The *incorrect* quantities listed in the order were:

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The order determining satisfactory proof on Transfer Application T-9981, recorded at Special Order Volume 81, Pages 793 - 795 is amended to correctly describe the amount by which Certificate 83571, at point of diversion #11, is reduced, as listed in Finding of Fact #3.
2. All other provisions of the order are unchanged.
