ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN TYPE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7634 submitted by

ASSOCIATED DITCH COMPANY
CARE OF DARRELL MCFETRIDGE

ENTERPRISE, OREGON 97828

The right to be modified, was perfected under Permit R-5018 with a date of priority of JUNE 5, 1967. The right allows the storage of the waters of WALLOWA RIVER, a tributary of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, in WALLOWA LAKE RESERVOIR for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is limited to 5257.0 ACRE FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

The right to store the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use.

The applicant proposes to change the type of use to:

Multi-Use including but not limited to Agricultural and Municipal uses.


THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.

2. The quantity of water stored for the new uses shall not exceed the quantity of water stored under the original use.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water stored. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. When requested by the Department, the water user or irrigation district shall report on the use of stored water when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source.

When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
