Findings of Fact

- 1. On December 20, 2006, BASIL MICHAEL ELIAS filed an application to change the point of appropriation under Certificate 49470. The Department assigned the application number T-10285.
- 2. On November 5, 2010, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the proposed change in point of appropriation. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 83, Page 30.
- 3. On March 13, 2012, the Water Resources Department issued a superseding and correcting order approving the proposed change in point of appropriation. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 87, Page 184.
- 4. On September 12, 2016, Basil Michael Elias notified the Department that the changes authorized under T-10285 would not be completed and requested that the authorized point of appropriation revert back to the original points of appropriation.

Conclusion of Law

The reversion of the point of appropriation authorized under Transfer Application T-10285 to the points of appropriation authorized under the water right prior to Transfer Application T-10285 is

consistent with OAR 690-380-6010(6). A superseding certificate for the right affected by the transfer shall be issued.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The point of appropriation authorized under Transfer Application T-10285 for the right described by Certificate 49470 is reverted to the point of appropriation authorized under the water right prior to the transfer.
- 2. A superseding certificate for that portion of Certificate 49470 approved for a change in point of appropriation by Transfer Application T-10285 shall be issued to confirm that portion of the right.
