ORDER APPROVING USE OF ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6351 submitted by

DICKMAN FARMS, INC.
15829 MT. ANGEL-SCOTTS MILLS HWY NE
SILVERTON, OREGON 97381

to use the waters of 3 WELLS in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 214.8 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by Certificate 43787, was perfected under Permit G-2377 with a date of priority of MARCH 15, 1963. This right is limited to 0.11 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at well 1.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by Certificate 52730, was perfected under Permit G-6391 with a date of priority of MARCH 17, 1975. This right is limited to 0.61 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at well 2.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by Certificate 61767, was perfected under Permit G-10720 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 24, 1987. This right is limited to 1.47 cubic foot per second; being 0.21 cfs from WELL 1 and 1.26 cfs from WELL 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The points of appropriation are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 7; NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 18, T 6 S, R 1 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 330 FEET NORTH AND 2210 FEET EAST, WELL 6 - 1060 FEET NORTH AND 2270 FEET EAST, WELL 2 - 920 FEET SOUTH AND 2310 FEET EAST, ALL FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

NOTE: The purpose of this transfer is to allow all of said lands to be irrigated from the original 2 wells (wells 1 & 2) and also from an additional well (well 6).

Certificates 43787, 52730 and 61767 are hereby cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming this water right will be issued.
