O R D E R
APPROVING APPLICATION
W-19

On June 4, 1941, the Squaw Creek Irrigation District and the World War Veterans' State Aid Commission filed an application for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Squaw Creek.

By decree of the circuit court for Crook County in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries, a water right was recognized for the irrigation from Squaw Creek of 16.5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 16 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1895, and 21 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1904.

The Squaw Creek Irrigation District, owner of the above-described land, proposes to transfer the water right appurtenant to 9 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 16 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., to 3.5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 21.5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1895, and to transfer water rights appurtenant to 21 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., to 21 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1904.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said

section provides that notice is not required in applications for only a change in place of use of water.

It appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved and that the water rights hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 9 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 16 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., having a date of priority of 1895, and 21 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., having a date of priority of 1904, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 3.5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 21.5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1895, and to 21 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 28, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1904.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1942, or such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
