Findings of Fact

- 1. On December 4, 2008, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-9282 from Charles Camis.
- 2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-9282 in the name of Gayle Werden, on February 24, 2005. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 63, at Page 344. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2007.
- 3. The Water Resources Department issued a correcting order on April 4, 2005 to correctly state the name of the applicant as being Charles L. Camis, rather than Gayle Werden.
- 4. The applicant has completed the identification of the new point of diversion and the proposed construction of the conveyance system on 2.47 acres and 1.50 acres.
- 5. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the applicant to obtain an easement, identify the point of diversion and complete construction of the conveyance system. The applicant was unable to complete the change due to easement denial, financial constraints and the complexity of the project.
- 6. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2013.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-9282.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-9282 shall be extended to October 1, 2013.
