Authority

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department’s procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On November 30, 2010, the Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-9836. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 83, Pages 136 – 146.
2. The order limited the quantity of water involved in the transfer. Those quantities contained a scrivener’s error and are described in the table below.
