Findings of Fact

- 1. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10241 in the name of Central Oregon Irrigation District on April 2, 2008. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 74, at Page 513. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2009.
- 2. On September 14, 2010, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-10241 from Central Oregon Irrigation District.
- 3. The property owner Nicholas Rachor has beneficially used the full 3.50 acres as allowed in the order. The property owner Vito Bartolotta has beneficially used 0.62 acres of the 1.75 acres allowed in the order.
- 4. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the Vito Bartolotta property to re-seed and irrigate the remaining acres allowed and beneficially use the water.
- 5. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2011.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10241.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-10241 shall be extended to October 1, 2011.
