On July 17, 1997, John F. Koehnke of 36840 SW Dixon Mill Road, Cornelius, OR 97113, submitted an affidavit to the Water Resources Department that he is the owner of certain land and a water right appurtenant to it. The affidavit further states a portion of the water right has been abandoned authorizes the cancellation of that portion.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 40830, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is the right to use storage from the reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4663 for supplemental irrigation of 5.0 acres in the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 27 and 0.4 acre in the NE¼ NW¼ of Section 34; the right to use 0.093 cfs from North Branch Campbell Creek and the reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4663 for the supplemental irrigation of 16.0 acres in the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 27; and the right to use 0.127 cfs from North Branch Campbell Creek and the reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4663 for the irrigation of 10.0 acres in the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 27 and 12.0 acres in the NE¼ NW¼ of Section 34, all in T 1 S, R 3 W, W M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that Certificate 40830 is canceled and a new certificate of water right describing that portion of the water right not canceled by the provisions of this order be issued.
