O R D E R


Now at this time the above entitled matter coming on for consideration before the State Engineer on the application of Robert H. Williams for the approval of a change in point of diversion, and it appearing that by decree of the Circuit Court for Wallowa County, dated January 20, 1919, a water right was recognized in the name of S. P. Williams for the irrigation of 4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  with a date of priority of 1896, and 6 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , all of Section 11, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1895.

That Robert H. Williams, as successor to S. P. Williams, proposes to transfer these rights without loss of priority to a 10 acre tract in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

That it further appears the water right can be more beneficially used on the tract upon which it is proposed to make the transfer and that no other rights would be injured by the change in place of use.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in place of use be and the same is hereby approved without loss of priority for the rights heretofore established, provided that said water to be transferred is applied to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W.M., within one year from the date of this order.
