EXTENDING TIME

Under certain orders of the State Engineer heretofore entered approving changes in use, place of use and/or point of diversion of water of the above-named persons, the time limit was fixed to apply water to beneficial use and/or complete construction work as provided by Section 47-712, Oregon Code 1935 Supplement.

The time limits having expired, it is urgent that a decision be made upon these applications in order that the applicants may proceed to complete the construction work in connection with a change in point of diversion and/or apply the water to beneficial use upon the lands to which the water was heretofore transferred.

Actual examination of the premises of applicants is practically impossible due to limited personnel and funds, and the State Engineer is, therefore, compelled to judge the matter of diligence entirely on the statement contained in the respective applications for extension of time.


The statements contained in the applications for extension of time indicate that each applicant has shown such reasonable diligence as entitles him to an extension of time.

No protests or objections to the granting of an extension of time have been filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the applications for an extension of time within which to complete the construction work and/or apply water to beneficial use upon the new lands be and the same hereby are approved and that said time hereby allowed each applicant is set forth opposite his name as follows, to-wit:
