Findings of Fact

- 1. On September 21, 2017, the Department issued a Final Order and Superseding Permit G-17817 for a change in points of appropriation proposed under Permit Amendment Application T-12276 and approved by Special Order Volume 105, Page 820.
- 2. Superseding Permit G-17817 contains a scrivener's error omitting the rate and duty paragraph found in the original permit, G-13878.
- 3. The superseding permit should be corrected with the addition of the rate and duty paragraph from the original permit, G-13878. The paragraph is as follows: "The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year."

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. Permit G-17884, in the name of Kenneth J. Reynolds, is issued to replace Permit G-17817, and incorporates the correction approved by this order. Permit G-17817, in the name of Kenneth J. Reynolds, is no longer of any force or effect.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

2. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 105, Pages 820-822 remain in effect.
