ORDER


On July 18, 1997, Randy and Cynthia Norton of 85108 Fitzgerald Lane, Milton-Freewater, OR, 97862, submitted an affidavit to the Water Resources Department that they are the owners of certain land and a water right appurtenant to it. The affidavit further states the water right has been abandoned and requests its cancellation.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right evidenced by Certificate 1732, State Record of Water Right Certificates, namely the right to use 0.065 cfs from Springs in the watershed of Middle Branch Mud Creek for irrigation of 5.06 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21 in T 6 N, R 35 E, W M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that Certificate 1732 is canceled and a new certificate of water right describing that portion of the water right not canceled by the provisions of this order be issued.
