ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. T-72

On January 20, 1967 Lillian E. Tussing filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Deschutes River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of the Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company for the irrigation of, among other lands, 0.5 acre in SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with a date of priority of September 1, 1899, tabulated in the name of R. A. Bickford. This right was confirmed by certificate recorded at page 29054, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

Lillian E. Tussing, owner of the land above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom without loss of priority to 0.5 acre in the SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 15, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water only.


NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described

as appurtenant to 0.5 acre in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with a date of priority of September 1, 1899, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 0.5 acre in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1968.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company at the time certificate is issued to the Company confirming other transfers within the Company.
