On November 23, 1984, R.H. Hill, President of Lloyd M. Hill, Inc. of PO Box 12726, Salem, Oregon 97309, submitted an affidavit that Lloyd M. Hill, Inc. is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that Lloyd M. Hill has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Malheur County, entered May 13, 1925, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Malheur River, tabulated in the name of Pacific Livestock Company, at page 299, Volume 8, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is described by the certificate recorded at page 50447, Volume 44, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Glanville Farms, Inc., and is for the use of not to exceed one-twentieth cubic foot per second per acre of water from Clover Creek, with a date of priority of 1884, for irrigation of 7.5 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, 40.0 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, 40.0 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 22.0 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, 40.0 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 7.5 acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, 20.0 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 41 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, described by the certificate recorded at page 50447, Volume 44, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled.
