**Authority**

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department’s procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

**Findings of Fact**

1. On October 3, 2011, the Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-11283. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 85, Pages 487 - 491.
2. The order limited the quantity of water, at points of diversion #1 and #11, involved in the transfer. Those quantities contained a scrivener’s error and are described in the tables below:
