The Water Resources Department (Department) received an affidavit from the owner of lands stating he has abandoned the use of water described by the ground water registration certificate appurtenant to his land and requests cancellation of the registration. The Water Resources Director has reviewed the affidavit and makes the following disposition of the request:

STATEMENT OF FACTS


The Department received an affidavit from James M. Whitmore, 115 N. Main, Lot 17, Milton-Freewater, Oregon, stating he is the owner of land to which the entirety of Ground Water Registration Certificate 3741 is appurtenant. The affidavit states the entirety of the registration appurtenant to the property has been abandoned and requests the ground water registration certificate be canceled.

Ground Water Registration Certificate 3741 allows for the use 200 gallons per minute (gpm), for irrigation of 40.0 acres within Tax Lot 400, NW¼ SE¼ of Section 15, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M. The tentative date of priority is 1921.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the entirety of Ground Water Registration Certificate 3741 for the use of 200 gpm for irrigation of 40.0 acres within Tax Lot 400, NW¼ SE¼ of Section 15, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., with a tentative date of priority of 1921, has been abandoned and is hereby canceled.
