ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7081 submitted by

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 62342, was perfected under Permit G-10160 with a date of priority of JULY 19, 1983. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 7.3 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.091 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 36, T 26 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 50 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 36, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 68204, was perfected under Permit G-10703 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 4, 1983. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 24.7 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well: SE1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 25, T 26 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 30 FEET NORTH AND 3000 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 25, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

PERMIT G-10703

NE¼ SW¼ 7.6 ACRES NW¼ SW¼ 7.5 ACRES SW¼ SW¼ 9.6 ACRES SECTION 25

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

PERMIT G-10160 NW¼ SW¼ 7.3 ACRES SECTION 36 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

PERMIT G-10160 NW¼ SW¼ 24.7 ACRES SECTION 36 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 36, T 26 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 50 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 36.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.

- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of thess water rights.

Certificates 62342 and 68208 are canceled. New certificates will be issued to confirm those portions of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes are received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
