


Conclusions of Law

The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11586 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11586 is approved.
2. Permit G-17272 in the name of RUPP RANCHES, is issued to replace Permit G-16671, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-16671, in the name of RUPP RANCHES, is no longer of any force or effect.
3. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
4. Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation at each new point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
6. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-16671 remain the same.
