Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On May 16, 2016, JRS PROPERTIES III LP filed an application to change the points of appropriation and to change the place of use under Certificates 86190, 88583, and 88584. The Department assigned the application number T-12386.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on May 24, 2016, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On January 20, 2017, the applicant submitted a revised application and map.
4. On July 5, 2017, the watermaster submitted a new watermaster review based on the newly amended application and map finding no injury or enlargement.
5. On December 7, 2017, the applicant submitted an amended transfer application and map for a portion of the transfer.
6. On December 18, 2017, the applicant submitted an amended transfer application and map for a portion of the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

7. On December 19, 2017, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12386 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of January 19, 2018, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
8. On April 5, 2018, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12386 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on April 10, 2018, and in the Lake County newspaper on April 11 and 18, 2018, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notices.
9. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of no to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

18. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
19. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-12386.
20. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
21. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
22. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law


The change in points of appropriation and change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12386 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in points of appropriation and change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12386 are approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 86190, 88583, and 88584 and any related decree.

3. Water right Certificates 86190, 88583, and 88584 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.
4. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. **Before water use may begin** under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each new point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters; provided however, where the meters are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
7. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2020**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
9. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
